## LAKESIDE STATEWIDE JURIED ART EXHIBITION

### 2025

Entry into the **28<sup>th</sup> Annual Lakeside Statewide Juried Art Exhibition** is open to all artists 18 years of age and older, living or working in New York State over the last 2 years. Acceptable media include: drawing, painting, sculpture, mixed media, printmaking, photography, digital media, ceramics and all fine craft. Work previously exhibited at the Oswego Civic Arts Center is not eligible. Work completed prior to 2022 is not eligible. Entries should be appropriate for all ages. All accepted works must arrive suitably framed and ready to hang or otherwise appropriately prepared for immediate installation. Unframed works or works improperly prepared may be rejected. Works may not exceed 72" in any direction. Sculpture may not exceed 100 lbs.

### Jurors

**Billie Jo Peterson** has lived and worked in Central New York most of her life. She earned a BFA from Alfred University with a concentration in Drawing and Painting and a Master of Science for Teachers at RIT. She has been an art teacher in the Oswego City School district for over 25 years. She also enjoys working with Ceramics, Printmaking, Photography and Metals.

**Robert Love** is an award-winning Central New York woodworker and mentor. While his education led to a degree in Electrical Engineering, wood turning and wood carving have been the focus of his artistic efforts since 2006. His work takes the form of both functional and sculptural pieces. He is an active member and Board member of the Woodworkers of Central New York.

### Awards

\$1000 in prize money is guaranteed, with \$300 for Best of Show. The award ceremony will be held at 8 pm on opening night.

### Gallery

The Art Association of Oswego (AAO) galleries are housed in the Oswego Civic Arts Center, which is located at the northern end of East Fourth Street in the City of Oswego, directly across from historic Fort Ontario. Regular gallery hours are on Saturdays from 10 am to 1 pm and on Sundays from 1 pm to 4 pm. The galleries are also accessible on Wednesdays during open studio hours from 10 am until 2 pm, and during any art classes, theater performances, music events and by appointment.

### Terms and Conditions

Artists whose work is accepted will need to check the website for delivery procedures. No work may be withdrawn or removed before the end of the show. Works on exhibit may be offered for sale. The Art Association takes a 30% commission on all sales. The Art Association reserves the right to photograph accepted works for publicity purposes. Entry into this exhibition will constitute agreement by the artist to the terms described herein.

Friday, March 21...Hand-delivery of accepted works at the AAO from 10 AM to Noon

Saturday, March 22...Hand-delivery of accepted works at the AAO from 10 AM to Noon

Saturday, March 29...Exhibition opens with a reception from 7 to 9 pm with (awards at 8 pm)

Sunday, April 27...Exhibition closes at 4 PM

Sunday, April 27...Pick up work at the AAO from 4 to 6 PM\*

Monday, April 28...Pick up work at the AAO from 6 to 8 PM\*

Monday, April 28...Return of shipped artwork begins

**Information about each artwork entered (limit is three):**

**2. SUBMIT DIGITAL IMAGES OF YOUR WORK AS ATTACHMENTS TO YOUR EMAIL:**

One image of each artwork entered must be submitted as an individual **jpeg** file\*.  
Files should be at least **300 dpi** resolution, **5 megabyte** (2000 kb) **or less** in size.  
Each digital file must be named with **artist's last name** plus a **shortened version of the artwork's title**  
(e.g. a file for Joshua Jones' entry entitled *Black Lake in Winter* might be named **JonesLake.jpg**)

\*For **3-Dimensional** works you may submit up to **three views** of each work
